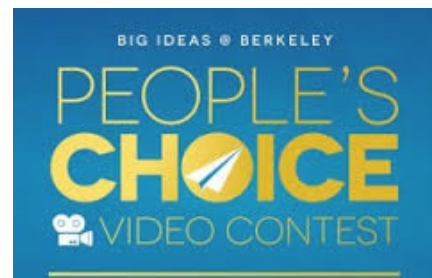

The intergovernmental process on agriculture has often been fraught with disagreement.
